Eligibility Criteria and Application Checklist:

- 1. A completed copy of this form, including payment of the \$135 application processing fee.
- 2. Current membership with the Heart Rhythm Society as a Physician.
- 3. Two letters of support from current FHRS members. *A list of FHRS members can be found at www.HRSONline.org/FHRS. The letters may be addressed to the Membership Committee and sent either with the application or separately to the Heart Rhythm Society.*
- 4. A cover letter by you documenting your interest in FHRS.
- 5. Current certification by the American Board of Internal Medicine or American Osteopathic Board of Internal Medicine in Clinical Cardiac Electrophysiology.

FHRS Application Process:

- Completed applications from eligible candidates are considered by the Membership Committee.
- Please allow approximately four weeks for the Membership Committee to consider your request.
- The Membership Committee reviews applications throughout the year. However, completed applications must be received by March 31 in order to be considered in time for induction at the Annual Scientific Sessions.
