


CENTRAL ILLUSTRATION: Sinus Rate Responses During Ventricular Tachycardia and Potential Clinical Implications

Sympathetic
52.0% (135/261)



Vagal
17.0% (45/261)



Untolerated VT:
Cardioversion ≤150 s

48.0%
Inappropriate responses
OR untolerated VT: 17
($P < 0.001$)

Clinical implications for inappropriate sinus responses to sustained VT:
Atropine may improve hemodynamic VT tolerance in 70% of cases
